Arriving in Perth

The Crowne Plaza Perth is located in the East pocket of Perth City at 54 Terrace Rd, Perth. Taxi's & Uber's are readily available at the airport on arrival. We can also assist with private airport transfers - please contact our team for assistance.

On arrival at the hotel, you'll need to provide a credit card hold for any extra charges and the team at Crowne Plaza Perth will provide you with our welcome pack & your room keys.

Parking

If you've requested parking, limited hotel parking is available for \$30 per day and can be used for multiple entry/exits. Street parking is also available to park for free between 6pm and 8am. Another option is FMG parking, just a 2 minute walk to the hotel with the rate of \$14 for over 1 hour between 6am to 4pm and \$10 from 4pm to 5.59am.

Breakfast

If you've pre-paid our group breakfast, it's available in Gusti Restaurant and Bar located on the ground floor of the hotel from 6am on Friday and 6:15am on Saturday & Sunday. Just quote your room number to the restaurant staff on entry. Please note the restaurant can seat up to 50 guests at a time and seating is based on a first come, first served basis. To avoid queues, please attend breakfast at a convenient time throughout the morning. If you have not prepaid your breakfast, please note that normal hotel breakfast rates & opening times (from 730am) apply.

Hotel Wifi

Daily Coach Transfers

Coach transfers are available for pre-booked athletes & their family members only. You will find coach passes in your welcome kit which need to be presented each time you board the coach. Please note two coach routes are operating:

- Red Route to/from Crowne Plaza Hotel
- Green Route to/from Holiday Inn & InterContinental Hotels.

Signage will be available on the windscreen of each coach to indicate the route its operating.

Your coach transfers will operate to/from the front of the Crowne Plaza Hotel at the following times:

Please note that positions on the coach transfers are based on a first in, first served basis and the coach will depart strictly to schedule. We strongly recommend you use the most preferred coach time for your competition needs to ensure the athletes requiring earlier competition attendance can be prioritised for the first departures.

Your coach transfer will take between 15 and 25 minutes depending on traffic. For your own safety & to comply with West Australian law please use any installed seat belts on the coach.

Places to visit in Perth

If you have some spare time during your trip, we recommend visiting:

Kings Park

Kings Park is one of the world's largest and most beautiful inner city parks. It is rich in Aboriginal and European history, contemporary culture and offers innovative design, displays and services. Kings Park has an international reputation for scientific research, leading horticulture, conservation and public education.

Kings Park is home to the spectacular Western Australian Botanic Garden, which displays over 3,000 species of the State's unique flora. Two thirds of the 400 hectare park is protected as bushland and provides a haven for native biological diversity.

Visitors can enjoy sweeping views of the Swan and Canning Rivers, the city skyline and the Darling Ranges to the east. Bushland walk trails, immaculate gardens and parklands and a variety of children's discovery play areas can all be found in Kings Park. The Visitor Information Centre, free daily guided walks, Aspects of Kings Park gallery shop, cafes and public transport are easily accessible.

Perth Mint

The Perth Mint is Australia's official bullion mint and wholly owned by the Government of Western Australia. With multiple daily tours, you'll be able to see behind the scenes of the mint.

Fremantle

There's always plenty of things to do in Fremantle. Just 30 minutes from Perth City, Fremantle is renowned as Perth's Old Town, full of vibrancy, colour and culture.

The streets buzz with the song of buskers, the sidewalks fill with a wild collection of art and the music that floats out from trendy cafés and bars.

Along with plenty of dining options, it's also worth visiting Fremantle Prison, the Fremantle Markets, the Maritime Museum or just enjoy browsing local shops & boutiques.

Rottnest Island

Rottnest Island is a perfect island day trip from Perth, with direct ferry transfers available from Perth city. After the 90 minute ferry ride you'll find a protected nature reserve, that's home to the quokka, a small wallaby-like marsupial. White-sand beaches and secluded coves include the Basin, with its shallow waters, and Thomson Bay, the main hub and ferry port. Strickland Bay is known for its surf breaks, while reef breaks occur at Radar Reef, off the island's far western tip.

Elizabeth Quay

The new place to see and be seen in Perth. Here you'll find the island playground, the BHP Billiton Water Park, public artwork, promenades, Bell Tower, Segway tours, river cruises and a range of bars and restaurants. The free CAT bus stops right at the Bell Tower.
